- Develop and maintain an informational and response capability for addressing development problems and opportunities
- Provide an appropriate focus on the major social and economic goals and issues of the day
- Provide input to influence community attitudes and lifestyles regarding development
- Apply research to innovative applications in land use planning
- Seek meaningful ways for all Councils to relate to and interact with each other
- Capitalize on the efforts of ULI’s membership to strengthen the Institute’s overall impact and thrust

The Requirements:

- Maintain ULI Full Membership
- Payment of yearly Council Dues (by fiscal year, 7/1-6/30)
- Attendance and participation at two out of three consecutive Council meetings
- Requires ULI conference registration
- Participate in and suggest Council Day sessions

The Method:

- Complete the [Navigator](#) interest form for the Council(s) in which you are interested
- Guest with Council as a *try-out*

The Financials (approx.):

- Full Membership - \$336 to \$1332 (non-profit/academic/public vs. private)

- One-year Council Affiliation Fee - \$725
- One-year Council Dinner Fee - \$250 to \$1000 (varies by Council)
- Fall meeting registration - \$2275 to \$2740 (early bird vs. late reg)
- Spring meeting registration - \$1175 to \$1325 (early bird vs. late reg)
