Long Beach Civic Center

Learn from the players behind the \$520 million public-private partnership to revitalize the civic core of downtown Long Beach. In 2015, City Council approved a plan to partner with Plenary-Edgemoor Civic Partners to design, build, finance, operate and maintain the new City Hall and Library for the next 40 years. The project also includes the construction of a new Port Administration building, financed separately using revenue bonds. The Long Beach Civic Center project also includes a new Main Library, a revitalized Lincoln Park, and opportunities include mixed-use residential, retail and a hotel
