**ULI's Homeless to Housed (H2H)** initiative is seeking District Councils interested in exploring real estate solutions to homelessness. Councils may apply for up to \$30K USD and staff support to advance research partnerships, technical assistance activities, and local programming.

## We are seeking proposals aligned with these priority themes:

- Increasing production of deeply affordable housing
- Connecting stakeholders (i.e., Public-Private-Provider Partnerships or P4s)
- Leveraging available land and/or structures
- · Aligning divergent community perspectives and financial resources

## THREE OPPORTUNITIES FOR FUNDING

Each opportunity requires a local sponsor match (amount negotiable). Funded projects must be executed/documented within 12 months (FY25).

# RESEARCH PARTNERSHIPS

#### **GRANTS UP TO \$30K USD**

Supports collaboration with H2H on a pre-determined research topic. Research interests include, but not limited to, Federal/State Policy and Local Impacts.

# TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

#### **GRANTS UP TO \$15K USD**

Supports organizing and executing local technical assistance activities such as a PAS, TAP, and/or ASP \*.
