Spotlight on Impact

Every day the Lewis Center sees the impact of our programs of work, whether its driving industry change, shaping cities and regions, or cultivating champions. Here is one example:

At ULI's Spring Meeting in New York City, the Lewis Center led a **total of 21** sessions that **engaged over 2,100 attendees** on a variety of sustainability related topics. New York's Pier 57 was a vibrant venue for the one-day Lewis Center Sustainability Forum, with **over 100** people in attendance. Survey responses showed **96%** of participants found the day to be valuable and a good use of their time.



One participant noted: "Pier 57 provided the perfect backdrop for the [Lewis Center] Sustainability Forum as its redevelopment is a convergence point of so many ULI domains (i.e. urban revitalization, sustainable development, public private partnerships, public green space, community economic development)."

Another one shared: "Fantastic day overall, excellent timing, venue, mix of people, etc. Really outstanding."






Grant Opportunities for ULI District & National Councils


