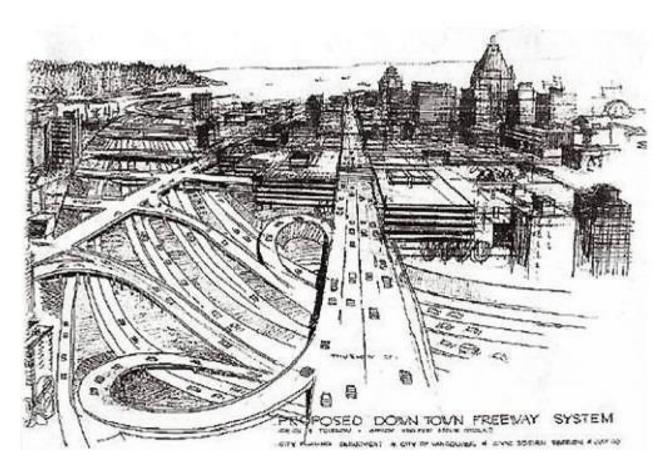


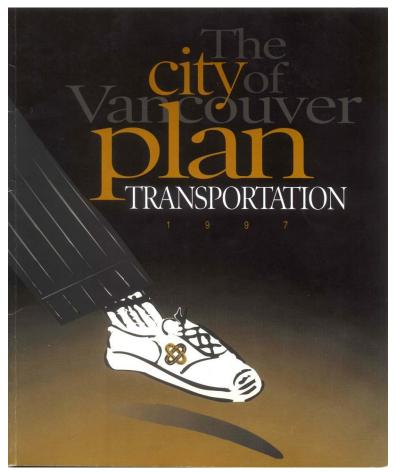
## The Freeway never built

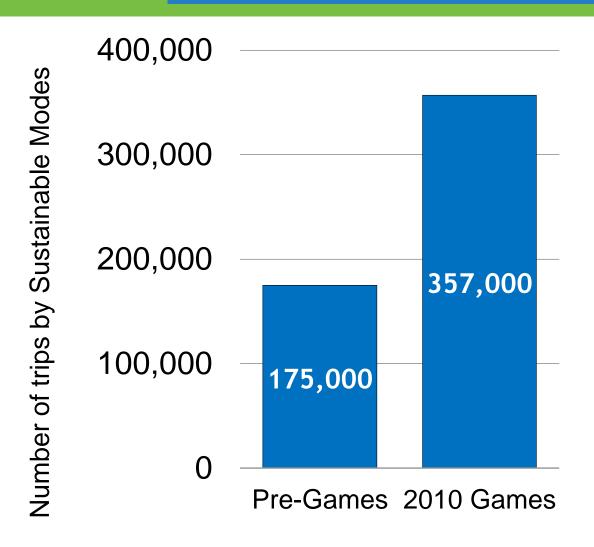

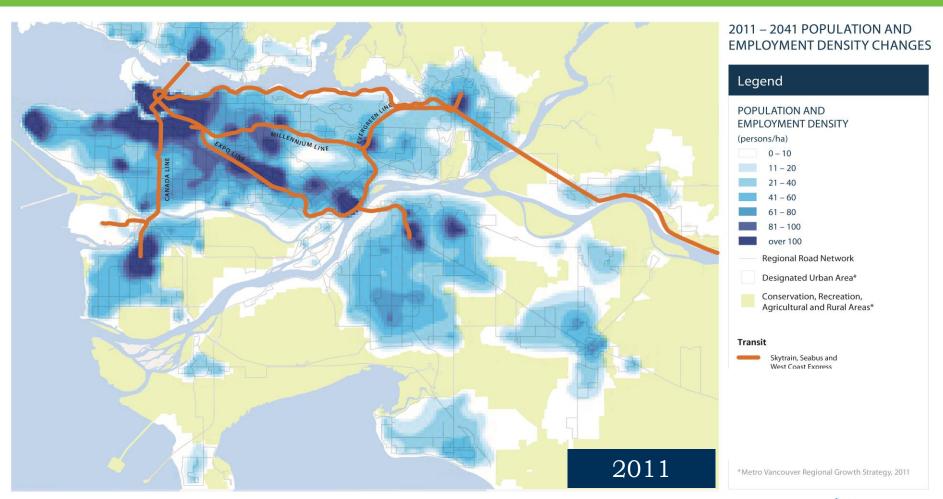

# Past Growth: Has Occurred Along Rapid Transit Lines



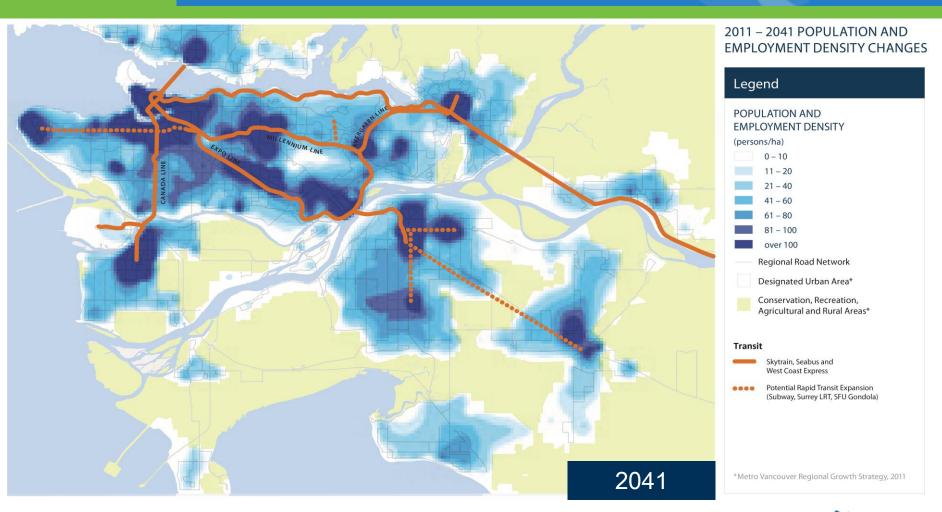
