What is it?

The ULI Health Leaders Network is empowering real estate and land use professionals with the skills, knowledge, and networks to improve health outcomes in their professional practice and communities.

By bringing together professionals from the fields of public health, planning and design, and development, the Network facilitates creative collaborations and provides actionable knowledge on development and design strategies that improve health and well-being.

What are the benefits?

Participants will gain valuable skills, connections, and knowledge that will help them advance their careers.

- Network: Be part of a robust cross-sector network of real estate and land use professionals with advanced knowledge about connections between real estate, planning, and health, including access to current Health Leaders and national advisors.
- 2. Learn: Cultivate leadership skills to advance careers as well as learn about best practices, research, and actionable approaches about health and the built environment.
- 3. Make a Difference: By advancing a culture of health in real estate and land use decision making, improve health and wellness for all people.

What does the program entail?

The program will begin with two cohorts, each running for one year and including approximately 30 participants each. The first cohort runs from October 2017 through June 2018. The second cohort will begin in October 2018.

Participants in the Health Leaders Network are expected to attend two in-person forums, which will focus on leadership development and network building. The introductory forum will be held in conjunction with ULI's Fall Meeting in Boston (October 8-11, 2018) and the closing forum will be held in May 2019 at ULI's headquarters in Washington, DC.

Health Leaders will also participate in **five interactive webinars** exploring topics related to health and land use and interact with others in their cohort through small group assignments and peer reviews of individual assignments.

Who can become a Health Leader?

Both ULI members and non-members are eligible to participate as Health Leaders. Non-ULI members will be expected to become Associate members for the duration of the program. Professionals from the real estate development, public leadership, urban planning and design, infrastructure, finance and investment, and health disciplines (including the medical industry) are encouraged to apply.



How will Health Leaders apply and be selected?

Applicants will be selected through a competitive process based on the following criteria:

- **Education**: Undergraduate or higher degree.
- Work Experience and Background: ULI Health Leaders will have at least 5-7 years of professional experience and will be a diverse group of emerging and established leaders, from a range of career stages and disciplines.
- Commitment: Participants must commit to attend 4 out of the 5 monthly webinars, and to attend the 2 inperson forums. If accepted to this competitive program, participants are pledging in good faith to be fully engaged and involved. Organization or supervisor approval to participate in this program is required.
- Interest in Health: Ideal candidates will have a demonstrated interest in and commitment to improving public health through their professional work.

Does it cost money to apply or participate?

No. Applying and participating in the ULI Health Leaders Network is free. Limited travel support will be offered to select participants for travel to the forums. No other stipends are provided.

What is the timeframe?

Applications for Cohort 2 of the Health Leaders Network will open in May 2018, and the program will officially kick off in October.
