Infrastructure 2014 uses survey findings and other data to assess the role of infrastructure in supporting and attracting metropolitan real estate investment and supporting urban prosperity, and identifies key infrastructure investment priorities and bottlenecks.

Infrastructure 2014, the eighth in a series of annual reports from the Urban Land Institute and EY, is full of essential information and insights for anyone who cares about infrastructure, real estate, and the future of cities.
